"Technological breakthrough and potential opportunities of the EAEU countries"

The strategic benchmark of the Eurasian Partnership is the creation of additional cumulative opportunities in the common economic space for attracting new, breakthrough, creative technologies, innovations, and highly qualified personnel for production of competitive products in the global market.

For these purposes, the EAEU countries need to jointly revise industry standards and develop a coordinated policy for innovation introduction and technological exchange. Integration should become an advantage for the five countries, on their path to a quality leap into industrial development.
