**"Technological breakthrough and potential opportunities of the EAEU countries"**

*The strategic benchmark of the Eurasian Partnership is the creation of additional cumulative opportunities in the common economic space for attracting new, breakthrough, creative technologies, innovations, and highly qualified personnel for production of competitive products in the global market.*

*For these purposes, the EAEU countries need to jointly revise industry standards and develop a coordinated policy for innovation introduction and technological exchange. Integration should become an advantage for the five countries, on their path to a quality leap into industrial development.*

The Eurasian network is called upon to become an element formulating a single digital market in the EAEU.</b></p> <p><b>Currently, the following services of the Eurasian Network have been implemented:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>service support of investment projects;</b></li> <li>- <b>leasing service;</b></li> <li>- <b>rental of high-tech equipment and services;</b></li> <li>- <b>technology requests and offers service;</b></li> <li>- <b>automated formation of reliable electronic registers of enterprises and products, etc.</b></li> </ul>

Within the framework of the forum, you will learn about the composition of thematic marketplaces for the year 2019, the target vision of the Eurasian Network service window, the architecture of service interaction, and the organizational model of involvement of enterprises of the pilot national segment (Republic of Armenia).
